DEMOCRATIC DESIGN

Over the last couple years we at IKEA have been exploring what it means to design for everyone, creating new products that respond to real people's needs, from students in dorm rooms to large families in large houses. And in our research we've discovered that home transcends a fixed location and instead resides in feelings of safety, familiarity, and relaxation that often extend beyond the four walls of a residence. This has led us to centre our new collection around a group who is not often associated with home furnishings: the homeless.





THE HEMLÖS COLLECTION

The objects we own go beyond form and function to enable our activities, and provide channels for our experiences. The Hemlös collection provides the homeless with the means to claim public space in hostile cities that are often actively trying to push them to the perifieries. We want to allow the homless to put their own needs first without sacrificing the security that invisibility can provide. For some there is no option besides public space—and they deserve the ability to make themselves at home.




How it works.
